IKYTA ORGANIZATIONAL PRINCIPLES:

- 6. Foster free and transparent flow of information, consciously and gracefully, among all individuals and all parts of the organization.
- 7. Recognize and honor wisdom, expertise, and all thoughts and actions grounded in higher consciousness and selfless service.
- 8. Encourage and foster sharing, mutual support, collective enrichment, and a trust in abundance.
- 9. Promote development and growth of the Kundalini Yoga community, and work to assure the integrity and coherence of the whole.
- 10. Maintain the highest standards of personal and professional integrity, accountability, and performance.
- 11. When a conflict arises, find resolution that serves the needs of all parties and accomplish this through deep listening, and loving and honoring communication.
